
By November, 2025, This is how Gift turned out to be. Thanks to the kindness and We are grateful that Spirit embassy too got on board with the December package

Description (Implementation Detail)	<p>On December 24th, a team of 4 H2D representatives delivered food and essential items to 20 vulnerable families in Mityana, supported by Spirit Embassy "The Good News Church". The packages included bread, rice, sugar, eggs, soap, and milk for malnourished children. Notably, 20 families (56% of 36 members) benefited from Spirit Embassy's contribution, while 16 members were supported by H2D volunteers.
